1) Definition

- i) The term 'Contract' shall mean and include the invitation to tender, incorporating also the instructions to Service Provider/Handling Agents, the tender, its annexure and schedules, acceptance or tender and such general and special conditions as may be added to it
- ii) The term ' Confed' wherever occur shall mean "The Haryana State Federation of Consumers Cooperative Wholesale Stores Ltd." and will include its District Manager and its successor or successors and assigns.
- iii) The term ' Managing Director ' shall means Managing Director Confed. The term District Manager' shall mean District Manager Confed District office concerned.
- iv) The term' Service Provider/Handling Agents' shall mean and include the person or persons, firm or company with whom the contract has been placed including their heirs, executors, administrators, successors and their permitted assigns as the case may be by Managing Director , Confed.
- v) The term ' Services' shall mean the performance of any of the items of work enumerated in the tender, additional and incidental duties, services and operations as may be indicated by Managing Director Confed or any officer acting on his behalf.
- vi) The term contract ' rates' shall mean the rates of payment per quintal accepted & approved by Managing Director Confed.
- vii) The term ' Godown' shall mean and include depots, godowns belonging to or in occupation of Confed or Service Provider/Handling Agents godown in joint custody
- viii) The term ' Pulses' shall mean and include Pulses, products of Pulses etc. whether imported or produced in India.

2) **Objects of work/description of work**

Service Provider/Handling Agent shall do transportation, cleaning, weighing, packing, labeling of Pulses in accordance with the instructions given to him from time to time by Managing Director Confed or District Manager, Confed.

- i) To provide loading handling and transportation at Port Town/Ex-Warehouse Mumbai for loading of Pulses in the Railway rack.
- ii) Unloading of Pulses from the Railway rack at the destination, timely clearance of Railway Yard, if any, transportation from Railway yard to the godown as informed by Confed, Unloading of Pulses in the godown and proper stacking thereof.
- iii) Cleaning as per specification notified by Confed.
- iv) Packing in one kg. specified pack of plastic pouches , weighing labeling, including printing, grading of Pulses in accordance with Packages Control Act and to keep the packed material properly in bags and their weight may vary from 10 Kg. to 25 Kg. per unit /bag etc.
- v) Transportation of packed Pulses from Godown to Confed District offices/Focal Point and loading, unloading involved therein.

Pulses stored in the godown of Service Provider/Handling Agent shall remain in joint custody of both the parties. The Pulses should be stored in scientific manner, so that it does not get damaged or lost in any manner.

Before receiving the supply from the Service Provider/Handling Agent and also supply to the consumer, packed pulses, will be got tested in the Food & Supplies Department Lab. to ascertain quality product to the consumer.

Note :- In Foreign matter, the impurities of Animal original shall not be more than 0.10% by weight.

3) The Service Provider/Handling Agents must get themselves full acquainted with terms and conditions of tender, location loading/unloading points before submission of tender or rates. Once a tender is submitted it shall be deemed that Service Provider/Handling Agents have fully acquainted himself with the terms and conditions, general information.

4) The Service Provider/Handling Agent shall have to quote rate as per objects of work/description of job mentioned above in the prescribed proforma as per Appendix – II. Implication of payment of CST, VAT and Service Tax wherever applicable be given separately.

5) In case the rates are quoted in a manner other than mentioned above, tenders are liable to be ignored. The Service Provider/Handling Agents should not incorporate any condition in the tender, as conditional tenders are likely to be ignored.

6) Tender form should be filled neat, clean and should be sent in sealed cover,. There should not be any cutting/overwriting in the tender form

7) **Parties to the contact:-** The parties to the contract are the Service Provider/Handling Agents and Confed represented by Managing Director Confed or District Manager, Confed. Notice or any other action to be taken on behalf of Confed may be taken/given by the District Manager of Confed.

8) **Volume of work :-** No definite volume of work to be performed can be guaranteed during the currency of contract. The Confed will also have exclusive right to appoint one or more Service Provider/Handling Agents at any time during the tenure of contract for any or all services. No claim shall lie against the Confed by reason of such division of work.

9) **Information about Service Provider/Handling Agents:-** The Service Provider/Handling Agents must furnish full, precise and experience in this field/nature and accurate details in respect of information asked for in Appendix - I attached to the form of tender.

10) **Signing of tenders**:- Person or persons signing the tender shall state in what capacity he is or they are signing the tender e.g. as sole proprietor of a firm or as a Secretary/Managing Director etc. of a limited Co. In the case of a partnership firms the names of all the partners should be disclosed and the tender shall be signed by all the partners or their duly constituted attorney, having authority to bind all the partners in all matter participating to the contract. The original or an attested copy of the partnership deed should be furnished alongwith the tender. In case of a limited company, the names of signing the tenders is empowered to do so on behalf of the company. A copy of the Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company shall be attached to the tender. In the case of Hindu Undivided family, the names of the family members should be discussed and the karta, who can bind the firm, should sign the tender form and indicate his status below his signature.

The persons signing the tender form or any document forming part of the tender on behalf of another or on behalf of a firm shall be responsible to produce a proper power of attorney duly executed in his favour, stating that he has authority to bind such other person or the firm as the case may be, in all matters pertaining to the contract. If the person so signing the tender, fails to produce the said power of attorney his tender shall be rejected. The person/firm/Co./HUF who remained as defaulter/black listed by Govt. or Semi Govt. offices or State procuring agencies including FCI shall not be entitled to submit the tender. Such tender shall be rejected out rightly. The Service Provider/Handling Agents has to submit affidavit duly attested by Notary to this effect.

The Power of Attorney should be signed by all the parties in the case of partnership concern, by the proprietor in the case of proprietary concern and by the person who by his signature can bind the company in the case of a limited concern. In case of Hindu Undivided Family, the Power of Attorney should be signed by the karta who by his signature can bind his family.

11) **Earnest Money** :- Each tender must be accompanied by an earnest money of Rs. 5.00 lac in the form of a demand draft issued by a scheduled bank in favour of Managing Director Confed payable at Chandigarh. No online cheque shall be accepted. Earnest money in the shape of bank draft shall be accepted only.

Tenders not accompanied by earnest money in the form prescribed above shall be summarily rejected.

The earnest money shall be liable to forfeiture if the Service Provider/Handling Agent after submitting his tender resiles from or modifies his offer. It being understood that the tender documents have been made available to him and he is being permitted to tender in consideration of his agreement to this stipulation. The earnest money is also liable to be forfeited in the event of the Service Provider/Handling Agent withdraw before the validity period or tenders failure, after the acceptance of his tender, or fail to furnish the requisite security deposit by the due date without prejudice to any other rights and remedies of Confed under the contract and law or give any false incorrect /declaration. **The earnest money will be returned to all unsuccessful Service Provider/Handling Agents, as soon as practicable after decision on tenders and to a**

successful Service Provider/Handling Agent, after he has furnished a security deposit, if the successful Service Provider/Handling Agent does not desire the same to be adjusted towards the security deposit. No interest shall be payable on the amount of earnest money. Negotiation shall be held with L-I only.

12) **Security deposit :-** The successful Service Provider/Handling Agent shall furnish security money/deposit of Rs. 25.00 lac within 72 hours of the acceptance of his tender by the Confed and acceptance of the offer is conveyed by Managing Director Confed to the Service Provider/Handling Agents in writing.

The security shall be deposited in favour of Managing Director Confed payable at Chandigarh in the form of demand draft of scheduled bank. Besides security, Service Provider/Handling Agent shall provide two tangible sureties of Rs. 10.00 lac each to Confed.

The security deposit furnished by the Service Provider/Handling Agent would be subject to the terms and conditions given in this tender and Confed will not be liable for payment of any interest on the security deposit or any depreciation thereof. The security money shall be refunded after satisfactory completion of contract and getting No Dues Report.

The successful Service Provider/Handling Agent will ensure that the necessary documents authorizing the person who has signed the Tender/Contract to bind his firm or the company have been filled properly in accordance with law.

13) **Documents attached to tender :-** Attested copies of partnership deed and power of attorney must be submitted by the Service Provider/Handling Agent alongwith the tender After a final decision about the tender is taken the successful Service Provider/Handling Agent shall produce original partnership deed and power of attorney within 3 days of the acceptance of tender, failing which Confed will be entitled to cancel the contract at the risk and cost of Service Provider/Handling Agent and forfeit earnest money and security deposited by him.

The Service Provider/Handling Agents should submit tender in sealed Envelopes/cover in tact, duly filled in complete and signed on each page of tender form Tender not accompanied by all the schedules/appendix intact, and duly filled in and signed may be ignored/rejected by Confed.

14. Delivery of tender:-

The Service Provider/Handling Agent should submit tender form in two –tier system i.e. (i) Technical bid in Appendix -I and Financial bid in Appendix -II in separate sealed envelopes. Both the sealed envelopes shall be placed in a master sealed envelope superscribing **Tender for appointment as Service Provider/Handling Agent for transportation, cleaning, packing, labeling of Pulses.** The technical bid should contain self attested copies of all credentials, documents and copies of certificate/information called for would be submitted as per tender paper alongwith EMD. The financial Bid should contain only the rate sheet as prescribed at Appendix -II. The financial bid of only technically qualified parties will be opened. Technical bid without EMD will be rejected immediately.

15) **Opening of Tender** :- The tenders will be opened at the time and on the date indicated in tender form. The Service Provider/Handling Agents will be at liberty to be present either in person or through an authorized representative at the time of opening of tender. Tender shall be opened first on the due date and time specified in the presence of the Service Provider/Handling Agent or their authorized representative who will remain present.

However, if due to some unavoidable reasons the tender can not be opened as per fixed schedule, time and date of opening of tender shall be intimated to Service Provider/Handling Agents by Confed at the time of submission of the tender. The tender shall remain valid for acceptance upto and including of 30 days from the date of opening of tender or to the extension of said date for further 30 days in case, it is decided by Managing Director Confed. In case any Service Provider/Handling Agents withdraw the tender before the validity period, the earnest money deposited shall be forfeited without giving any notice.

16) **Scrutiny of the tenders** :- Scrutiny of tender shall be done by Confed in consultation with Managing Director. Necessary clarification required by them shall be furnished to the Service Provider/Handling Agents during the opening of tenders.

It should be clearly understood by the Service Provider/Handling Agent that no opportunity shall be given to them to modify or withdraw tender at a stage when the rates are known to all Service Provider/Handling Agent.

17) **Corrupt practices** :- Any bribe, commission or advantage offered or promised by or on behalf of the Service Provider/Handling Agent to any officer or servant of the Confed shall (in addition to any criminal liability which the Service Provider/Handling Agent may incur) debar his tender form being considered. Canvassing on the part on behalf of the Service Provider/Handling Agent will also made his tender liable to rejection.

18) **Acceptance of tenders** :- Confed reserves the right to reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason and Managing Director Confed reserve the right to accept the tender. After final acceptance of tender, no request for further increase of rate shall be entertained. The successful Service Provider/Handling Agent will be informed of the acceptance of his tender by a letter or formal Acceptance of Tender by Managing Director, Confed.

19. In case the lowest Service Provider/Handling Agents fails to deposit the security or also fails to execute agreement within 72 hours of the issue of the acceptance letter, the earnest money/security deposit shall be forfeited without any further notice and Confed shall consider to award the contact to the next lowest party. In case the second or third party also does not undertake the work then Confed shall consider to invite fresh tenders.

No definite volume of work to be performed can be granted during the currency of the contract.

The Service Provider/Handling Agents must furnish full precise and accurate details in respect of information asked for in the tender form

20) **Subletting**:- The Service Provider/Handling Agents shall not sublet, transfer or assign the contract or any part thereof. In the event of the Service Provider/Handling Agents contravening the conditions the Confed shall be entitled to place the contract elsewhere on the Service Provider/Handling Agents account and at the risk and the Service Provider/Handling Agents shall be liable for any loss or damage which the Confed may sustain in consequence or arising out of such replacing of the contract. His security shall also be forfeited and he will be black listed.

21) **Liability of Service Provider/Handling Agent** :- All persons employed by the Service Provider/Handling Agent shall be engaged by them as their own employees/workers in all respects and the responsibility under the labour laws like Factories Act or Workmen Compensation Act or Employees Provident Fund Act or ESI, Health, Payment of Wages Act or Contract labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act 1970, Service Tax, Income Tax or any other similar enactments in respect of all such personnel shall be that of the Service Provider/Handling Agents.

22) **Deduction of Income Tax or any other tax** :- Deduction of Income Tax or any other tax and surcharge if any applicable shall be made at source per law enforce by Managing Director or District Manager, Confed District office concerned.

23) **Bribes Commission corrupt gift etc. :-** Any bribe, commission, gift or advantage given promised offered by or on behalf of the Service Provider/Handling Agents or any one of more of their partners/Directors/Agents or servant or any one else on their behalf to any officer/official, of Confed or any person on his or their behalf for showing or for bearing favour of disfavour to any person in relation to the contract, shall subject the Service Provider/Handling Agents to the conciliation of this contract or any other contract with Confed and also to payment t of any loss or damage resulting from such cancellation.

24) **Period of Contract** :- The contract shall remain enforce for a period three month from the date of acceptance of tender or such date as may be decided by Managing Director Confed Managing Director at his sole discretion who can extend the period of contract by another six months further beyond the original contract period on the same rates, terms and conditions and Service Provider/Handling Agent has to work accordingly. Managing Director Confed can terminate the contract at any time during its currency in case of any default/violation of terms and condition of tender without assigning any reason. Such communication shall be sent to the Service Provider/Handling Agents at his last known place of residence/business and the Service Provider/Handling Agents shall not be entitled to any compensation by reason of such termination. The notice for termination of the contract shall be given to the Service Provider/Handling Agents in writing by Managing Director Confed

The action of Confed under this clause shall be final conclusive and binding on the Service Provider/Handling Agent and shall not be called into question.

25) **Summary Termination** :-

a) In the event of the Service Provider/Handling Agent having been declared insolvent or going into liquidation or winding up his business or making arrangements with their creditors or failing to observe any of the provisions of this contract or any of the terms and conditions governing the contract, Confed

shall be at liberty to terminate the contract without prejudice or any other rights or remedies under the contract and to get the work done for the un-expired period of contract at the risk and cost of the Service Provider/Handling Agents and to claim from the Service Provider/Handling Agents entire loss sustained or costs incurred. In case any FIR is lodged against the Service Provider/Handling Agent on account of diversion or misappropriation of Pulses or mis-handling or wrong transportation, Confed is competent to terminate the contract and to forfeit the security money. Other action for recovery shall also be taken.

- b) Confed shall also have, without prejudice to other rights remedies the right, in the event of breach by the Service Provider/Handling Agents of any of the terms and conditions of the contract to terminate the contract forthwith and to get the work done for the un-expired period of the contract at the risk and cost of the Service Provider/Handling Agents and or forfeit the security deposit or any part thereof for the sum of sums due for any damages, losses charges, expenses or costs that may be suffered or incurred by the Confed due to Service Provider/Handling Agents negligence or un workman like performance of any of the services under the contract.

26) **Security deposit**

- a) The Service Provider/Handling Agent shall deposit security within 72 hours of the acceptance of their tender. Security amount will be deposited as prescribed in the invitation to tender failing which contract will be cancelled and the earnest money shall be forfeited.
- b) The security deposit will be refunded to the Service Provider/Handling Agents on satisfactory performance of the services and on completion of all obligations by the Service Provider/Handling Agents under the terms of the contract and on submission of a No Dues Certificate, subject to such deduction from the security as may be necessary for making up of the Confed claims against the contract.
- c) In the event of termination of the contract envisaged in Clause 25, the Confed shall have the right to forfeit the entire amount of security deposit of the Service Provider/Handling Agent or claim for any damage, loss, charges, expenses or costs that may be suffered or incurred by the Confed.
- d) The decision of the Confed in respect of such damages, losses, charges, costs or expenses shall be final and binding on the Service Provider/Handling Agents
- e) In the event of the security being insufficient or if the security has been wholly forfeited the balance of the total sum recoverable as the case may be shall be deducted from any sum due or which at any time thereafter may become due to the Service Provider/Handling Agents under this or any other contact with the Confed. If that sum also be not sufficient to recover the full amount recoverable, the Service Provider/Handling Agents shall pay to the Confed on demand the remaining balance due amount.
- f) Whenever the security deposit falls short of the specified amount the Service Provider/Handling Agents shall make good the deficit so that the total amount of security deposit shall not at any time be less than the specified amount.

27) **Liability of Service Provider/Handling Agents for losses etc. suffered by Confed.**

- a) The Service Provider/Handling Agents will be responsible to get the Pulses loaded into truck at Godown/Warehouse located at Port Town. He will be responsible for taking correct deliveries of consignment transportation by Rail /taking correct deliveries from Railway at destination point, transportation of stock by truck from Rail Head to the godown safe storage in godown, cleaning, weighment, packing and supply to Confed in the State. During this process, he will be responsible for any kind of shortage, pilferages, damages of goods and deviation of the quality of goods. etc.

The Service Provider/Handling Agents shall be liable for all costs, damages, charges and expenses suffered or incurred by Confed due to the Service Provider/Handling Agent negligence and un workman like performance of any services under this contract for breach of any terms thereof or their failure to carry out the work with a view to avoid incurrence of damages or losses caused to the Confed due to any act whether negligent or otherwise of the Service Provider/Handling Agents themselves or their Service Provider/Handling Agents and their liability for the losses etc. suffered by Confed concerned shall be final binding on the Service Provider/Handling Agents.

- b) The Service Provider/Handling Agents shall always be bound to act with reasonable diligence and in business like manner and to use such skill as expected of men of ordinary prudence in the conduct of their activities.
- c) The Service Provider/Handling Agents shall be responsible for the safety of the goods. Service Provider/Handling Agent shall be liable to make good the value of any loss, shortages or damage during transit. Managing Director will be the sole judge for determining after taking into consideration all the relevant circumstances, the quantum and value of loss and also as regards the liability of the Service Provider/Handling Agents for such loss and the amount to be recovered from them. The decision of the Managing Director Confed in this regard shall be final and binding on the Service Provider/Handling Agents.
- d) The Service Provider/Handling Agents shall provide sufficient number of tarpaulins for each truck/any other transport vehicle to cover the bags of packed Pulses and shall be responsible, if the packed pulses etc. are damaged by rain or any other any other way due to the Service Provider/Handling Agents failure to supply adequate number of tarpaulins or to take reasonable precautions. The decision of the Managing Director Confed in this matter shall be final and binding on the Service Provider/Handling Agents. The Service Provider/Handling Agents shall be liable for any loss which Confed may suffer due to the negligency.
- e) The Service Provider/Handling Agent shall strictly abide by all rules and regulations of Transport /Police/Municipal Authorities /District Administration and other Govt. regulations
- f) The Service Provider/Handling Agent will have to execute all the work to the full satisfaction of Confed and obey directions for proper execution contract or for speedy and careful handling.
- g) In case any dispute arises in respect of interpretation of any clause of the agreement, the same can be resolved by mutual discussion between the Service Provider/Handling Agent and Confed the matter will be referred to the Confed by either party whose decision will be final and binding on both the parties.
- h) In case of dispute between Service Provider/Handling Agent and Confed still persist and not resolved the matter will be referred to Managing Director Confed whose decision shall be final conclusive and binding on both the parties and shall not be called into question. Similarly for the recovery of amount of losses caused to the Confed by the Service Provider/Handling Agent due to misappropriation or diversion of pulses the matter shall be referred to Managing Director Confed for arbitration proceedings. Managing Director Confed can hear arbitration case himself or can appoint any officer of Confed or other Govt./Semi Govt. department as an arbitrator to hear the such reference and decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties to the contract. Matter to the arbitrator can be referred by Confed within 3 years from the date of cause of action.
- i) In case of any deviation of above stocks, Confed shall take criminal action against the Service Provider/Handling Agent, besides recovery the cost of such material at market rates/FCI rate, which are higher alongwith interest. He shall be responsible for deviation if any made by him or his employee. Managing Director Confed or District Manager Confed concerned shall initiate criminal, Civil and other proceeding to recover the cost of Pulses at market rate. Besides this FIR shall also be lodged. If any criminal proceedings are started against the Service Provider/Handling Agent or the police arrest the Service Provider/Handling Agent, Confed shall be competent to terminate the contract and forfeit his security. The work for the remaining period shall be got done from other sources without giving any notice.
- j) State Govt. instructions issued from time to time either by Managing Director Confed Director Food & Supplies Haryana or with reference to Pulses shall also be applicable apart from specific terms agreed by the parties.

Payment

- a) Payment shall be made by the Confed on submission of bills not later than 7th of next month duly supported and verified by concerned officers/officials of Confed or an officer acting on his behalf as the case maybe
- b) The Service Provider/Handling Agents should submit all their bills within 7 working days on completion of work/job failing which Confed will not be responsible for any delay in payment.
- c) Payment to the Service Provider/Handling Agents shall be made by Confed at the rates approved by Managing Director Confed

Laws governing the contract

The contract will be governed by the Laws of India for the time being in force.

In case of any dispute/ recoveries, not resolved /recovered at District level matter will be referred to Managing Director Confed whose decision shall be final and binding.

In case of any dispute arise between the Service Provider/Handling Agent and Confed, the matter will be referred to Managing Director Confed or to any other officer appointed by him on his behalf for adjudicating the matter of dispute under the provision of Arbitration Act 1996 and his decision shall be final and binding on both the parties.
